



Architecture Discipline Khulna University

Admission Requirements:

01. Candidates must hold a Masters in Architecture or allied disciplines (including Science and Engineering) from any university recognized by UGC.
02. Candidates must have completed at least 17 years of schooling at the time of application.
03. Private university graduates are also welcome to apply but should provide proof of UGC's approval of their concerned institution and campus where it was offered.
04. Applicant must have one CGPA 3 score on a scale of 4, or CGPA 3.5 on a scale of 5 (first division) in SSC or HSC or their equivalents, and one CGPA 3 on a scale of 4, or CGPA 3.5 on a scale of 5 (first class or equivalent in Bachelor or Masters). Third division/class (or equivalent) holders are not eligible.
05. In the case of masters without thesis, applicants must have at least one publication in a peer-reviewed journal as the principal author.
