1 About the Program

Architecture Discipline, Khulna University (ArchKU) offers PhD opportunities to aspirant candidates who strive for necessary skills and attitudes in critical knowledge accumulation, application of advanced and multidisciplinary research frameworks, data management and academic writing and publication. In the emerging context of critical, and informed/scientific decision-making, the program facilitates a unique cross-disciplinary platform for conducting advanced research of local and international relevance and scope. Within KU's lush green campus, the research/researcher will not only benefit from ArchKU faculties' diverse research portfolio and expertise, but also from KU's multidisciplinary environs and resources.

2 Research Areas

ArchKU PhD encourages proposals along lines of the following research streams:

1. Design, Communication, and Representation
2. Building Services and Technology
3. Environment and Behaviour
4. History, Theory, and Criticism

These streams may include, but are not limited to the specific areas of Space, society, and culture; Computation, visualization, fabrication, and simulation; Sustainability science and technology; Heritage and conservation; Resilient housing and settlements; Coastal disasters, dynamics, and climate change; Pedagogy; and Profession/Practice.

5 Funding Opportunity

As per Khulna University's standard rules and regulations, a PhD student may be eligible for BDT 10,000.00 worth of monthly scholarship for one year. In addition, the University may bear the cost of conference attendance.

4 Credit Requirements

13 Credits + PhD Dissertation + 15 points from peer-reviewed scholarly publications.

Each student shall complete 09 Credits from not less than three courses. The student will have options to earn the remaining credits by attending public seminars and peer-reviewed conferences.

3 Eligibility

Masters in Architecture or allied disciplines (including Science and Engineering) from any university recognized by UGC, provided the candidate has completed at least 17 years of schooling at the time of application. Private university graduates are also welcome to apply but should provide proof of UGC's approval of their concerned institution and campus where it was offered.

Applicant must have one CGPA 3 score on a scale of 4, or CGPA 3.5 on a scale of 5 (first division) in SSC or HSC or their equivalents, and one CGPA 3 on a scale of 4, or CGPA 3.5 on a scale of 5 (first class or equivalent in Bachelor or Masters). Third division/class (or equivalent) holders are not eligible. In the case of Masters without Thesis, at least one peer-reviewed publication as the first author is required.
